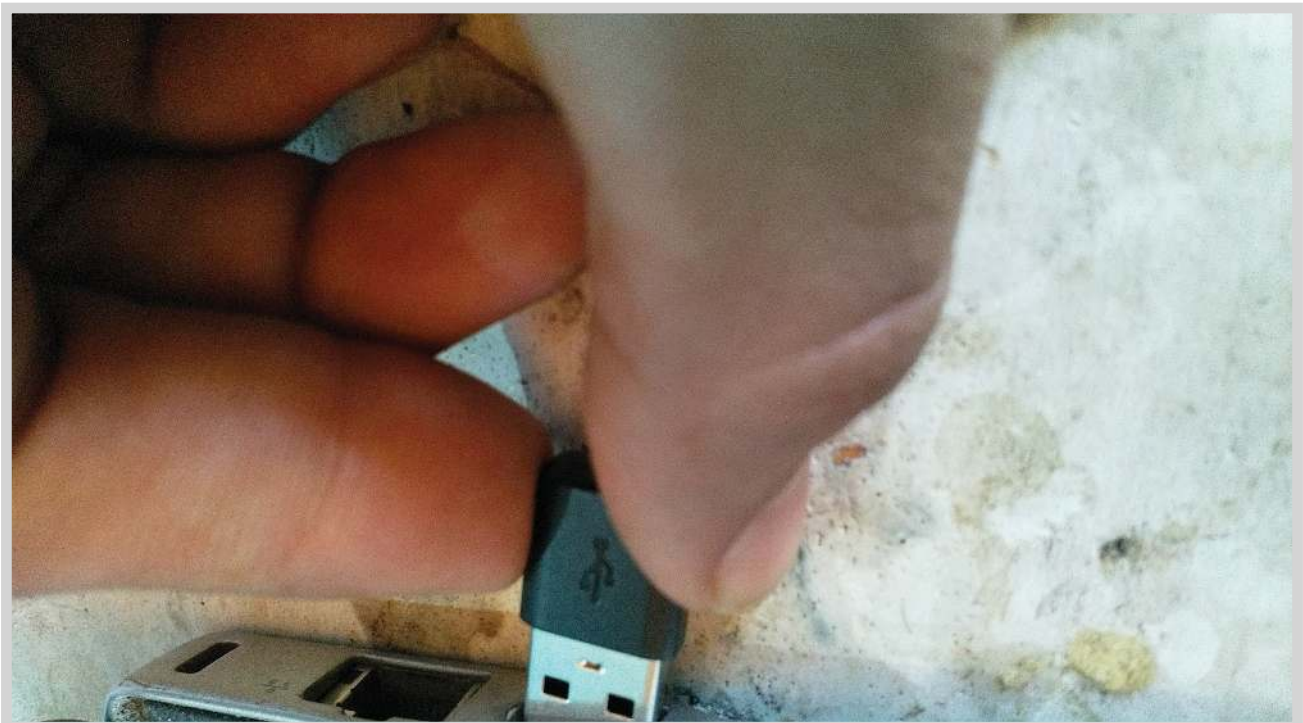


GUIDE TO TRANSFER
FILES FROM WINDOWS PC TO
YOUR ANDROID PHONE WITH
A USB CABLE

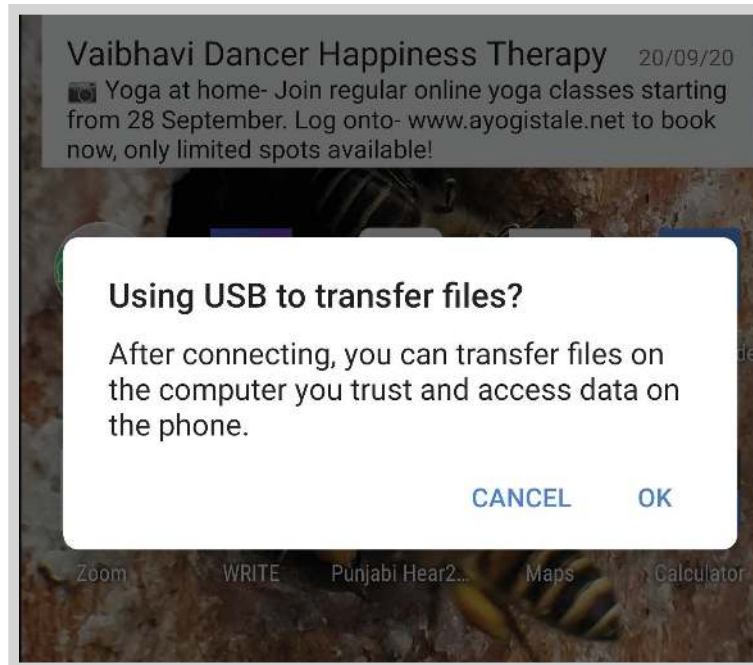
STEP 1: Connect the micro USB Cable to your Android Phone.



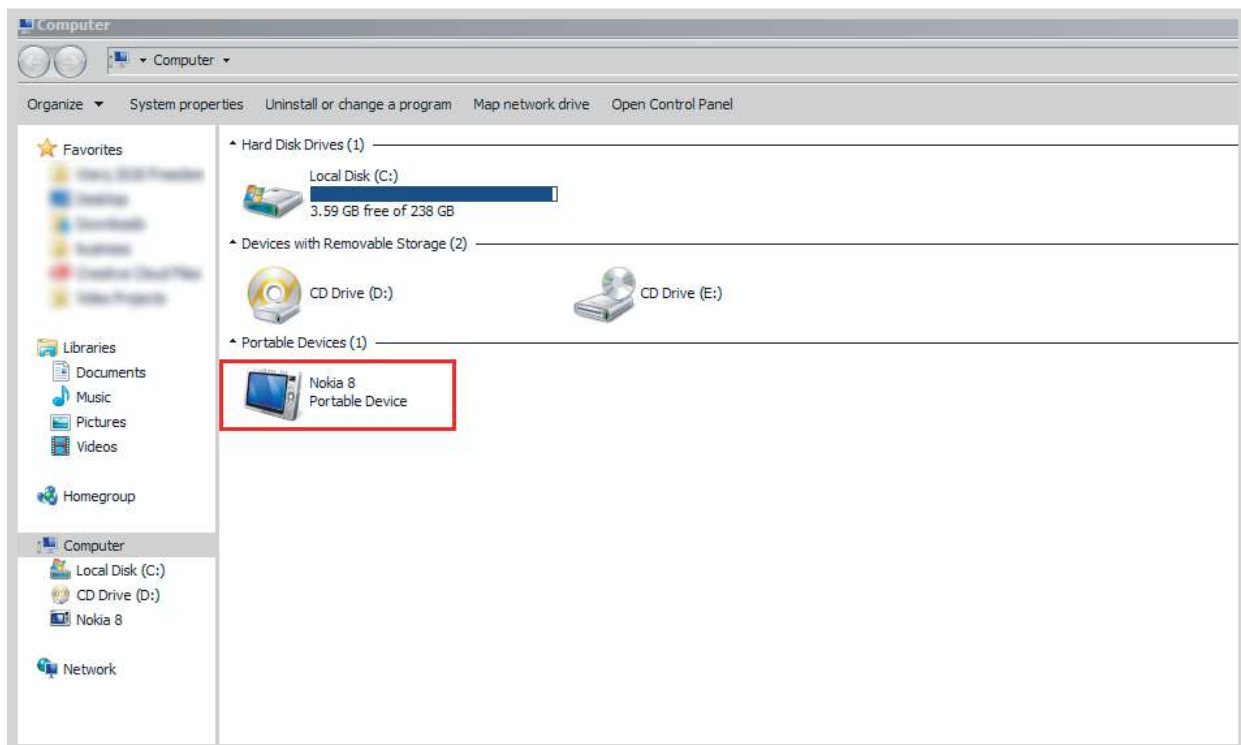
STEP 2: Connect the other end of the USB cable to your Windows PC in the USB port.



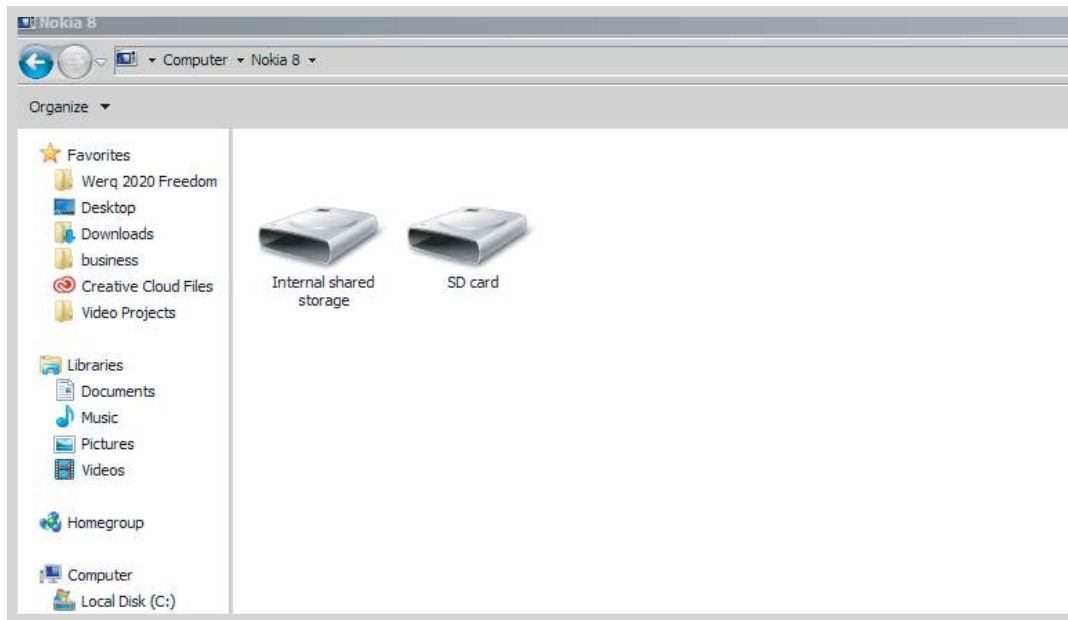
STEP 3: A pop-up would appear in your phone, asking for access to data via the USB cable. Allow Access.



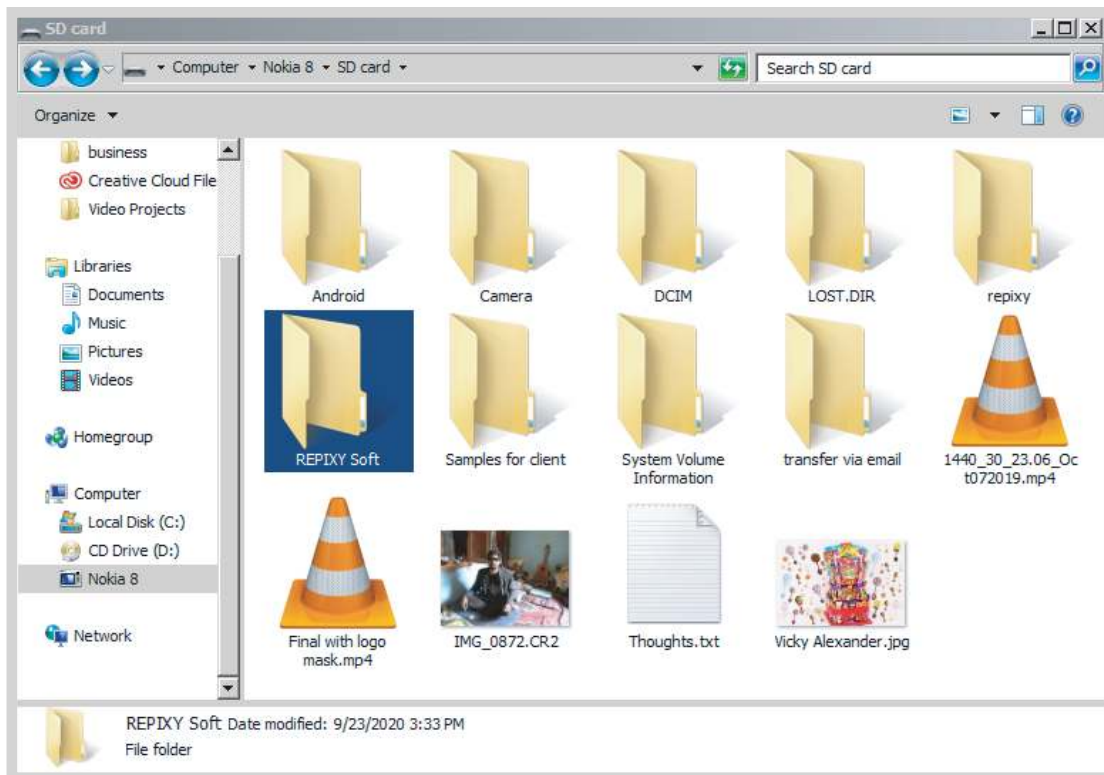
STEP 4: Now the Phone would appear as a Portable Device in My Computer.



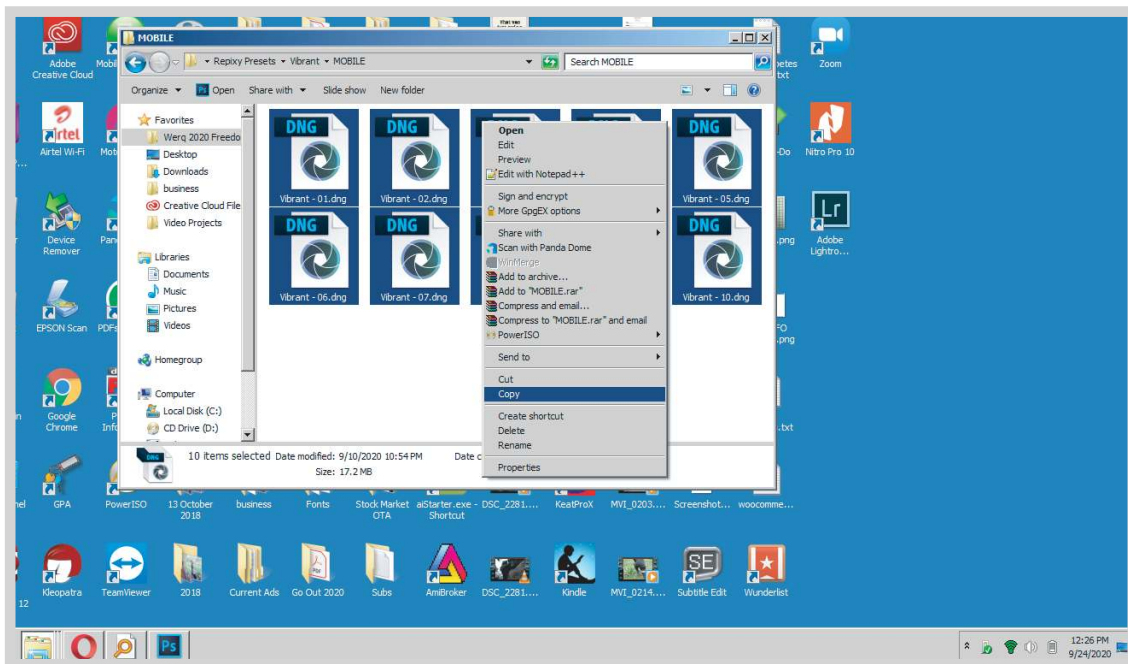
STEP 5: Open the folder and you would be able to access your SD Card and Internal Storage.



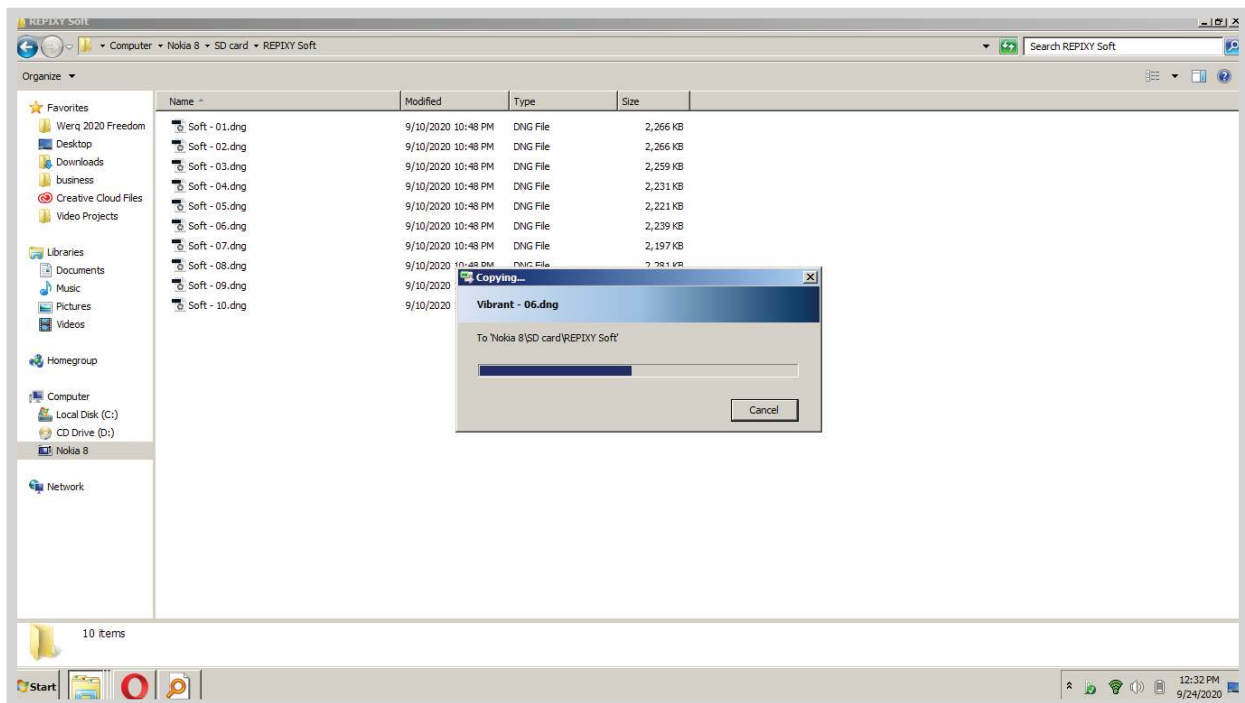
STEP 6: Choose the folder where you want to save your files. Open it.



STEP 7: Open Windows Explorer again and navigate to the files you want to copy to your phone. Copy them



STEP 8: Paste them in the folder you opened in step 6.



STEP 9: Now you can access the files in your phone!
